SUMMARY

With the beginning of the Russian-Ukrainian war in 2014, the occupying power, which is de-facto under control of central government of the Russian Federation, began the process of the systematic eradication of Ukrainian identity in the temporarily occupied territories of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, as well as parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

This process, under the nominal task of “integration into the educational space of the Russian Federation”, was implemented through the system of formal and informal education and aimed to form a loyal attitude towards the occupation authorities of the Russian Federation and cultivate “patriotic feelings” for the “new Fatherland” among children and youth from the temporarily occupied territories.

In 2022, after the full-scale invasion of the Russian Federation and the occupation of new territories of Ukraine, the processes of destroying Ukrainian identity by using the field of education became even more active and visible. For this purpose, new educational programs and instruments were developed and implemented, one of which is the “University sessions” project (hereinafter referred to as “University sessions,” project, program).

The basis for its creation was the “Writing the future” context for schoolchildren in the occupied parts of Donetsk and Luhansk regions, who were taken to the territory of the Russian Federation for practice-oriented trips (self-education) under the program “More than a trip.” Later, these trips transformed into a separate large-scale project called “University sessions,” which extended its activities to all temporarily occupied territories (hereinafter referred to as TOT). On July 7, 2022, after the first University session, the President of the Russian Federation V. Putin was personally informed about the “unbelievable effect” caused to children in the context of “formation of Russian identity” (which was, de-facto, the erasure of Ukrainian identity and the imposition of the Russian identity).

Taking into account the so-called “successes,” V. Putin instructed to continue and expand the project, which led to the involvement of new children from the occupied territories already in 2023. As of the date of drafting this report, project continues to operate.

Analyzing the collected information about the “University sessions” program, the authors of this report emphasize the danger of this project, which lies in its hidden goal – “re-education of Ukrainian children” and, as a result, destruction of the Ukrainian identity of children from the TOT.

The content of the program is aimed at imposing on children the feeling of affiliation with Russia and patriotism towards the aggressor state, while at the same time forming false ideas about Ukraine as a “Nazi” and “enemy” state.

The main target audience of “University sessions” is children in the age between 12 and 17 from the temporarily occupied territories of Donetsk, Luhansk, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions, as well as Crimea and the city of Sevastopol.

The key implementers of the program are educational organizations of higher education of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as Higher Education Institutions), which, under the slogan of “vocational guidance work” among the future entrants from schools in the TOT, contribute not only to the “re-education” of Ukrainian children, but also stimulate their admission to the Higher Education Institutions of the Russian Federation with the possibility of further permanent residence in Russia, which will lead to a change in the demographic composition in the TOT in the long run. For this purpose, the Russian Federation creates conditions for children to obtain Russian citizenship that have no alternatives – through forced passporting of residents of the territories occupied by it – and admission to Russian educational institutions at preferential terms.¹ At the same time, the opportunity to study in Ukrainian Higher Education Institutions is deliberately limited by the occupying country: due to the logistical obstacles in relocating from the occupied territory across the frontline, as well as actual impossibility of receiving Ukrainian education in the TOT – due to the transition to the standards of the Russian Federation and the lack of subjects of the Ukrainian studies cycle.

According to the terms of the Program, Russian Higher Education Institutions work directly with children from the TOT, applying psychological intervention to them and implementing a program aimed at forming Russian identity and popularizing Russian youth movements. Thus, there is a change in the consciousness of Ukrainian children, under the influence of psychological pressure, the identification of oneself as the citizen of Ukraine is lost – and at the same time, loyalty to the occupier state is formed.

These and other components of the “University sessions” program, which are described in more detail in this report, are violations of the norms of international law and should be stopped as soon as possible.

1 In 2022, budgetary places in 12 Higher Education Institutions of the Russian Federation were allocated for applicants from the TOT, most of which were participants of “University sessions”. In 2023, applicants from the so-called LPR, DPR, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions enter as citizens of the Russian Federation (presupposes obtaining the passport of the Russian Federation), they are able to enter institutes and universities based on the results of Unified State Exam, as well as based on the results of entrance exams, which will be conducted by the educational institution itself.

Children who studied at Higher Education Institutions of Ukraine, which ceased to exist and were located in the TOT of the so-called DPR, LPR, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions, who did not complete their studies in 2021/22 and 2022/23 academic years, will be admitted in the 2022/23 and 2023/24 academic years to study under the same educational programs at the Higher Education Institutions of the Russian Federation located in the TOT, at the expense of the budget, regardless of the availability of free places.

Legal qualification

The available evidence collected by the CCE Almenda indicates that the “University sessions” program is carried out en masse and organized for children from the occupied parts of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions, which since 2023 are called the “new territories”, in order to help them “integrate into the educational system of the Russian Federation” and encourage their further admission to the Russian Higher Education Institutions.² According to Article 43 of the Hague regulations, Russian occupying power does not have the authority to implement Russian federal legislation, but instead must respect the laws that were in force in the territory before the occupation. Also, the occupier state “in cooperation with state and local authorities, must promote the proper functioning of institutions responsible for the care of children and their education”.³ Programs, which instead are aimed at fundamentally changing the educational system in the occupied territories – as stated in the goals of “University sessions”, are contrary to the norms of International Humanitarian Law and are a violation of the rules of the regime of occupation, determined by the Hague Regulations, Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of Civilians, as well as customary norms of humanitarian law, which severely limit the powers of the occupier state and establish the rights of residents of the occupied territories to maintain a normal life, without significant interference from the temporary occupation administrations.

Another important point in the context of the “University sessions” program is the influence on the demographic composition of the occupied territories, because the “status quo” of the occupied territories can change either due to the fact that after studying the child decides to stay in the territory of Russia, or the child returns to the TOT for further work in the occupation administration of the occupier state, which arbitrarily implements its laws.

Regarding violations of the norms of international human rights law in the aspect of re-education

In the matter of managing the occupied territories, Russia is bound not only by the norms of the international humanitarian law, but also by the norms of international human rights law relative to the provision of rights and freedoms for the population of the occupied territories. The Russian Federation is a party to the 1989 Convention on the Rights of the Child, which enshrines the principle of the supremacy of “the best interests of the child” in all matters concerning the child – including the preservation of own identity (including civil identity), education and leisure.⁴ We believe that there is a violation of children’s rights due to the following:



Article 8 of the Convention stipulates that a child has the right to preserve one’s identity, which includes national identity. At the same time, the main focus of the Program is to

educate children from the so-called “new territories”, cultivating a “Russian civic identity” that would later turn them into real citizens of the Russian Federation and facilitate their further relocation to the Russian Federation for studying.⁵ We believe that such actions of the Russian authorities, who organize this program for children from the occupied Ukrainian territories, are a violation of the right to preserve the identity by encouraging to “pledge allegiance to the occupier state”.⁶ This is evidenced, for example, by lectures on the topic **“I am a citizen of my country”** (of Russia in the given context).⁷ The universities themselves also claim that Ukrainian children develop “Russian identity”.⁸

► Articles 28-29 of the Convention enshrine the child’s right to education, which also includes informal education that should be subject to specific criteria, called “objectives of education”:

- b) *The development of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms and the principles proclaimed in the Charter of the United Nations.*
- c) *The development of respect for the child’s parents, his or her own cultural identity, language, and values, for the national values of the country in which the child is living, the country from which he or she may originate and for civilizations different from his or her own.*
- d) *The preparation of the child for responsible life in a free society in the spirit of understanding, peace, tolerance, equality of sexes and friendship among all peoples, ethnic, national, and religious groups, and persons of Indigenous origin.*

Instead, the “University sessions” program provides activities related to militarization of Ukrainian children, such as, for example, children’s participation in the military-sports game “Zarnitsa”⁹ and visits to Russian military-patriotic education centers.¹⁰ Postulates about the “heroism of the Russian army” and the fight against “Ukrainian Nazism” during the current Russian-Ukrainian war¹¹ are also imposed on children. These actions contradict the aims of education

d) “The preparation of the child for responsible life in a free society in the spirit of understanding, peace, tolerance” and b) “The development of respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms and the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.”

The patriotic component includes the actual denial of Ukrainian cultural identity.¹² This is evidenced by the fact of attempts of involving children to “traditional Russian Values”¹³ and imposing “Russian civic identity” on them.¹⁴

It is known that in order to form Russian patriotism, during the sessions, children were involved in the ceremony of raising the Russian flag¹⁵ (in some sessions this was done daily¹⁶) as well as signing the national anthem of the Russian Federation.¹⁷ According to the methodologists of the sessions – Russian symbols and rituals are a necessity.¹⁸ Therefore, there is a violation of the following aim – “The development of respect for ... his or her own cultural identity, language and values, for the national values of the country in which the child is living, the country from which he or she may originate”.

▶ According to Article 31 of the Convention, a child has the right to rest and leisure, as well as to participate in cultural life. It should be noted that games and leisure cannot be imposed on a child, and participation in cultural life is important for the formation of child’s own identity. Thus, according to the UN Committee on the Rights of a Child, “compulsory or enforced games and sports or compulsory involvement in a youth organization do not constitute recreation.” For example, military education, which extends to children’s leisure as a part of general education and/or extracurricular activities, has the nature of “compulsory or enforced games,” which does not correspond to the spirit of the Convention.¹⁹

It is known that one of the organizers of the “University sessions” is “Movement of the First” organization, to join which children are actively campaigned during their participation in the sessions. In addition, “Movement of the First” actively promotes the ideas of Russian patriotism during the “University sessions”, for example, during the session at the Stieglitz Academy, in which children from the occupied Ukrainian territories took part.²⁰ It is known that government

of the Russian Federation is planning to involve every child in participating in this organization.²¹ Also, during the sessions, children take part in such military games as “Zarnitsa”,²² which are aimed not at child’s development, but at militarization, which does not comply with Article 31.

In addition, games and leisure used the Russian Federation in the programs of “University sessions” are aimed not at the “formation of own identity”, but rather at the replacement of Ukrainian identity with the Russian one (and it is not appropriate to say that by introducing children to Russian culture, Russia is trying to create good neighborly relationships).²³ Through leisure activities, such as excursions to the places of glory of the Russian Federation, museums and exhibitions,²⁴ respect for the history of the Russian Federation is imposed on children, attempting to adapt to the realities of being “citizen of the Russian Federation”.²⁵ Games (quests), patriotic films²⁶ are also used to impose Russian patriotism.²⁷ Therefore, games and leisure, which are not aimed at the comprehensive development of a child, but at the implementation of the state’s own policy regarding the pursuit of political goals (such as the imposition of identity), are incompatible with Article 31 of the Convention.

Such actions of the Russian Federation regarding the deprivation of Ukrainian children in the TOT of fundamental rights based on their nationality can be considered as a crime against humanity, namely, discriminatory persecution (Article 7.1.(h) of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court).

Regarding the fact of relocation

International humanitarian law establishes strict restrictions on the possible relocation of civilian population during the occupation – Article 49 of Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of Civilians prohibits forcible relocation and deportation of the civilian population by the occupier state. The term “forcible relocation” includes not only the use of physical force, but also “the threat of the use of force or coercion caused, for example, by fear of violence, coercion, detention, psychological pressure or abuse of power against such person or another person, or through the use of coercion”.²⁸

A key aspect in distinguishing forcible and voluntary relocation is the presence or absence of consent. Nevertheless, establishing the authenticity and awareness of consent for the relocation from protected persons under the control of the enemy state is not a simple task, and the bar for expressing valid consent is truly high,²⁹ especially considering the context of the occupation. This is particularly relevant in the context of the relocation of children, who, according to Article 77.1 of the Protocol Additional to Geneva Convention, shall be the object of special respect and shall be protected against any form of indecent assault.³⁰

From December 4, 2022 (that is, from the moment of the “ratification” of the so-called agreement on the accession of certain territories of Ukraine into the Russian Federation), we can talk about the de-facto lack of **documented parental consent** to relocate children to the territory of the Russian Federation. In particular, the Russian Federation stated that from December 4, 2022, the written consent of parents is no longer required for the transportation of a child across Russian state border from the territory of the so-called “LPR” and “DPR”, as noted by the so-called “Minister of Education and Science of LPR”³¹ and a “deputy” of the so-called “DPR”.³² There are cases, when **such consent is absolutely absent**, because children, who were in care institutions and whose legal representative is the state of Ukraine, were transferred to the territory of the Russian Federation. In particular, children from the “Luhansk Orphanage” took part in “University sessions”, namely – at the Pedagogical University of the Udmurt Republic (Russian Federation).³³ The so-called “notaries of LPR”³⁴ issued permits for relocation of children from the orphanage, as the so-called “principal” of this institution stated in particular.³⁵ It is also known about the participation of orphans in the “University sessions” program in Omsk region.³⁶

Such acts could potentially fall under the Rome Statute of the ICC as “enforced disappearance of persons”, which means “the arrest, detention, or abduction of persons by a State or political organization or with their permission, support, or tacit consent, with the subsequent refusal to recognize such deprivation of liberty or to inform of their fate or whereabouts stay of these persons with the aim of leaving them without legal protection for a long period”.³⁷ In such case, we can also talk about the actual child abduction, which is one of the serious violations against a child, defined by the UN Security Council based on the presence of all the elements.³⁸

At the same time, it is important for us to note that in view of the occupation situation taking place in the temporarily occupied territories of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia, Kherson regions,

as well as the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, where children who participate in the “University sessions” program are from, where Russian occupation administrations implement Russian laws, exert pressure on parents and intimidate them, we do not consider it possible to talk about authentically informed consent to the relocation of children to the Russian Federation, even among those whose parents de-jure agreed for their children to participate in the program. These theses are confirmed, in particular, in the study of “Amnesty International”, where, based on the interviews with victims who managed to leave the Russia-occupied territories, it is emphasized that parents are under intense pressure from the occupation administrations regarding attending schools and studying according to the Russian program, as well as there is pressure on children – for example, for refusing to sing the national anthem of the Russian Federation, students are threatened with being sent to an orphanage.³⁹ In other words, there may be many more cases when the “consent” of parents to participate in the program was given under pressure, and, therefore, it is de-facto absent – which means that there are also many cases of enforced disappearance and abduction of children for the purpose of their participation in the “University sessions” program, but it is impossible to identify and verify them using open sources, and they must be properly investigated after the de-occupation.

METHODOLOGY

The report covers the period from June 6, 2022, to August 31, 2023, and is based on the information collected by the public organization Center for Civic Education “Almenda” exclusively from the open sources, in particular:

- Messages from state authorities of the Russian Federation and occupation administrations.
- Official statistical data of the Russian Federation.
- Information posted on the official websites and official pages in social networks (including the social network “VKontakte”) of educational institutions of the Russian Federation, as well as those located in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.
- Information and messages from organizations, institutions and other bodies related to the implementation of “University sessions.”
- Mass media publications of outlets in the Russian Federation and in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.

In the framework of this report, the documenters of the public organization Center for Civic Education “Almenda” used only sources available to them. The collection and analysis of information continued until November 30, 2023. Information and messages that could not be verified as of the date of the publication of this report were not included in it.

The collection of information and monitoring was not conducted regarding the sessions of the “University sessions” project, in which children from the occupied territories of Ukraine did not participate.

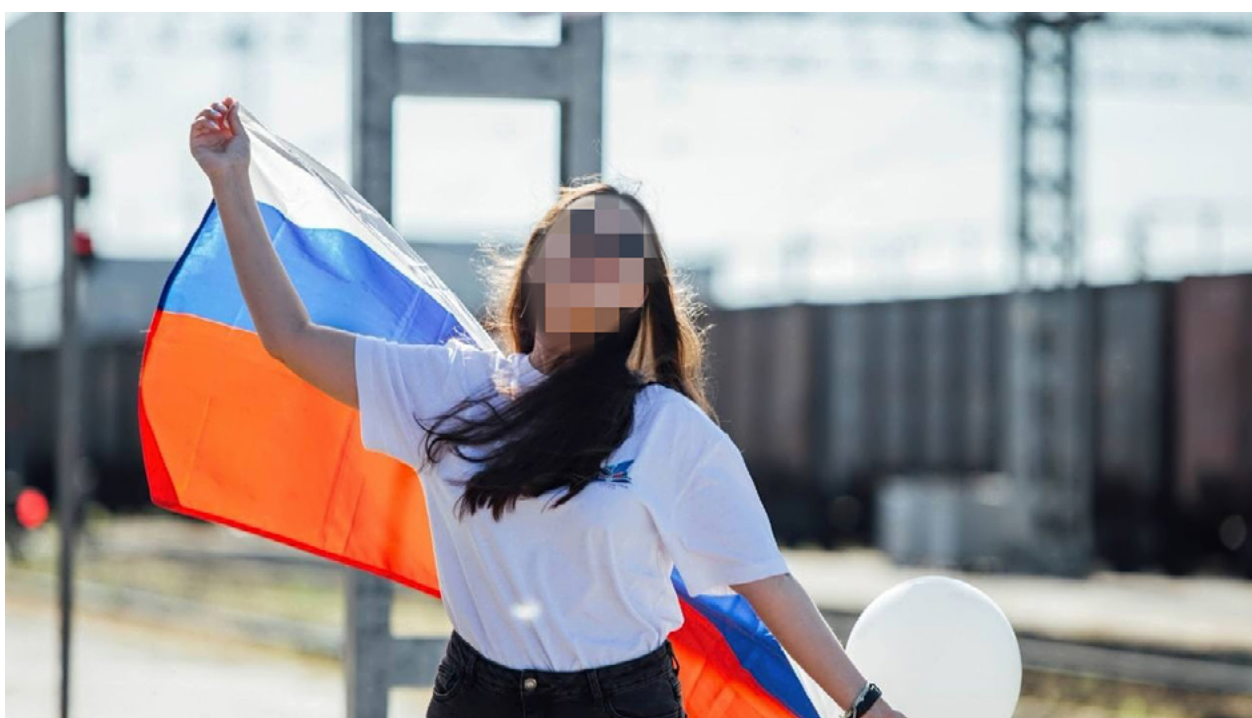

I. CONTEXT, TARGET GROUPS AND LEGAL BASIS

1. BACKGROUND – WHAT IS THIS PROGRAM ABOUT?

“University sessions” (Russ. - “*Universitetskiye Smeny*,” hereinafter referred to as “*University sessions*,” *project*) is a unified program that is held in campuses of Russian universities for children of the age 12-17, during the sessions 10 days each. “University sessions” began on June 6, 2022, as a pilot project for children from the so-called DPR and LPR, organized by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation with the participation of specialists



from RosMolodyozh and lecturers of the “Knowledge” society. It is noteworthy that the project was developed to fulfill the personal mandate of the president of the Russian Federation – Vladimir Putin.^{40, 41} The purpose of the program is career guidance and **formation of Russian identity, which is, de-facto, Russification of Ukrainian children, erasure of Ukrainian consciousness and stimulation of their relocation from the occupied territories for studying and further residence in the Russian Federation.**

One of the proofs of this is the comment of the representative of the occupation authorities – the adviser to the head of the so-called LPR, Marina Filippova:

“*In the “University sessions,” we deliberately emphasized that the participants were children from the liberated territories (note – TOT of Ukraine) and who are finishing their graduating classes. **They were determined to enter Ukrainian universities... but now** (note. – means after participating in “University sessions”) **they are ready to continue their studies in Russian educational institutions** (note. – author’s translation).*⁴²

Along with career guidance, the main objective of the project is the formation of Russian identity among children,^{43, 44} which indicates the actual destruction of their civic identity as Ukrainians. This is achieved through the development of programs of the sessions, which include invariable and variable parts, divided into six mandatory modules: *educational, cultural and patriotic, professional, sports, excursion, and recreational*. However, a mandatory condition of the program is a **patriotic focus** [Auth.note – in given context, towards the RF], which permeates the entire activity of “University sessions.”⁴⁵

Praising the results of the pilot version of the project in 2022, Vladimir Putin personally, in his instructions to the Russian State Council, issues the order to continue “University sessions” on a permanent basis, forming a program of civil-patriotic and socially useful youth tourism, which will include the mentioned project.^{46, 47} Therefore, in 2023, the unified educational program for high school students “University sessions”, the main task of which is the organization of **profile (thematic) sessions related to the formation of Russian identity** on the base of the leading universities of the Russian Federation, was included into the program of “Civil-patriotic and socially useful youth tourism “More than a trip”.⁴⁸

At the same time, in 2023, “University sessions” is scaled up, as noted, in particular, by the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation Valery Falkov – “it is planned to involve not only children from the new subjects of the Russian Federation, but also children of the participants of the SMO, veterans of military operations and heroes of Russia, as well as demobilized students from the new subjects” (*note. – by new subjects they mean the TOT of Ukraine*).^{49, 50, 51}

Along with the expansion of the categories of children involved, in 2023, new performers are involved in the “University sessions” project, in particular, the All-Russian public and state movement of children and youth “Movement of the First”, which is the organizer of certain sessions of spring and summer stages, for which a website for created,⁵² which contains the conditions of participation in the project, terms and requirements for participants.⁵³

Therefore, the “University sessions” project is one of the instruments of the Russian youth policy to influence children from the TOT of Ukraine, which began after the full-scale invasion of Ukraine and expanded its activity to all temporarily occupied territories, turning into a massive ongoing project.

2. TARGET GROUP – WHO PARTICIPATES?

In 2022, the organizers of the project report that the “University sessions” program is designed for schoolchildren in the age between 12 and 17 from the so-called Donetsk and Luhansk People’s Republics.^{54, 55} But in fact, in 2022, “University sessions” were also held for children from the temporarily occupied territories of Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions,^{56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61} as well

as Kharkiv region (*note. – at the time of its partial occupation*).^{62, 63, 64, 65} Also, some Universities, as executors of the project, report about the participation of children from 9 to 19 years old.⁶⁶

In 2023, “University sessions” take place with the participation of the “Movement of the First” and are conventionally divided into two types: the first are carried out by the “Movement of the First”, and one of the conditions for the participation is membership in the “Movement of the First” and registration on the official website of the movement; the second – without mandatory membership in the movement, however, the program of the session contains a day dedicated to the “Movement of the First”. In both cases, representatives of the movement hold meetings with children, talk about the prospects of membership in the “Movement of the First” and campaign for new children to join.

The participants of the sessions held by the “Movement of the First” were the winners of the competitive selection from among the activists of the Movement between the ages of 14 and 17 registered on the platform [будьвдвижении.рф](https://budvdvzhenii.ru).

It should be noted that in 2023, the age for participation in the sessions was increased compared to 2022, which, according to the authors of this report, is probably related to the fact that from the age of 14 children acquire additional legal identity, according to the legislation of the Russian Federation. In particular, from the age of 14, children are subject to the policy of the enforced passporting, which is implemented by the Russian Federation in the occupied territories. Obtaining a passport of the Russian Federation, among other things, allows a person to receive the right to join youth movements, as well as go on trips around Russia unaccompanied and without the notarized consent of parents. Taking advantage of this and considering the TOT of Donetsk, Luhansk, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions as “Russian” territory, after the so-called accession of those territories into the Russian Federation in October 2022, the Russian Federation relocates children according to the rules of internal moving around the country, without obtaining additional consent from parents or legal representatives.

The competitive selection, in particular, included the task of preparing a video, which would reflect the mission of the Movement: BE WITH RUSSIA, BE A HUMAN, BE TOGETHER, BE IN THE MOVEMENT, BE FIRST.⁶⁷ Such conditions of the competition are a part of the mechanism of destruction of Ukrainian identity among children from the TOT, because the mandatory requirement to use such theses as “be with Russia” in the video forces children to identify themselves as inseparable from the Russian Federation. The winners of the competition for the participation in the “University sessions” were chosen according to the approved quotas, which included: 157 children from the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine in the spring season, and 121 children in the summer season from the TOT of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and the city of Sevastopol, as well as so-called DPR and LPR, and the occupied parts of Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions.⁶⁸

Participation in other sessions of the “University sessions” project was massive, it was carried out without competitive selection, children received the offer to participate from teachers of the schools in the TOT where children study.⁶⁹ In turn, educational institutions received letters from occupation authorities with information about the number of children, dates and place of the sessions.

The comments of children from the TOT of Luhansk region are a confirmation of the offer from educational institutions:



Like many other children, who are travelling with me today, I joined the “Movement of the First.” My school offered me to participate in the sessions, I immediately agreed and was very happy about it.

The ninth-grader Danylo received an invitation as a school activist, and the eleventh-grader Sasha is a member of the “Movement of the First.”

Last year I already went to the “University sessions,” this year I joined the “Movement of the First” and together with the guys we are going to the HEI in Rostov (note – author’s translation).⁷⁰

In addition to the seemingly voluntary participation of children in the “University sessions” project, there were facts of the relocation of children without the consent of their legal representatives, in particular, the participation of orphans and pupils of boarding-type organizations from the TOT, whose legal representative was the state of Ukraine, which did not grant any permission for any relocation of them to the territory of the Russian Federation.^{71, 72, 73}

In order to transfer children across the board with the Russian Federation in 2022, the so-called notaries of the TOT issued the notarized letters of attorney, including for the transfer

of orphans.⁷⁵ After the so-called accession of the “new territories” (*note – which are the TOT of Ukraine*) into the Russian Federation in October 2022, notarization of consent or letter of attorney from parents is not required, only passport control remains for children to cross the border with the Russian Federation.⁷⁶

The fact of transferring of minors and underaged children to the territory of the Russian Federation for participation in the “University sessions” indicates blatant violations of the norms of international law by the Russian Federation, since it’s actually impossible to verify the authenticity of the documented consent of parents and guardians, as it is required by Ukrainian legislation. Documents issued by the so-called notaries in the TOT of Ukraine are legally null and void, and therefore transferring children to the Russian Federation is de-facto an illegal transferring across the state border of Ukraine. At the same time, it should be emphasized that in both cases – in the presence of the formal parental consent for children to leave, and in the case of forcible transfer of children for the participation in the “University sessions”, all children were subjected to intense indoctrination and Russification, because the main objective of the program is to destroy of Ukrainian identity of children from the TOT, as well as to change the demographic composition of the occupied territories through stimulating the relocation of youth for the permanent residence to the territory of the Russian Federation.

3. LEGAL BASIS – WHICH RUSSIAN LEGAL ACTS REGULATE THIS PROGRAM?

“University sessions” as a pilot project in 2022 was implemented as a part of the Concept of the Development of Additional Education of Children until 2030 and the Action Plan for its Implementation, which was approved by the Order of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 678-r, dated March 31, 2022. One of its measures was the organization of Olympiads and other competitive events for children and youth, holiday career guidance schools, profile, and specialized sessions. The executors are the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Sports of the Russian Federation, interested public organizations, executive bodies of the subjects of the Russian Federation. Financing was conducted at the expense of funds from the federal budget within the budget allocations provided for the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation and interested federal executive bodies.⁷⁷

The results of “University sessions” in the summer 2022 were announced at the meeting of the Presidium of the State Council on Tourism Development on September 6, 2022,⁷⁸ praising which,

Vladimir Putin orders to form the programs of civic-patriotic and socially useful youth tourism through the consolidation of successful youth projects and programs.⁷⁹

To exercise this order, the program of civic-patriotic and socially useful youth tourism “More than a trip” was created, which included a “unified educational program for high school students “University sessions”, the main task of which is the organization of profile (thematic) sessions on the formation of Russian identity, at the base of leading higher education institutions of the Russian Federation”, which is reflected in the Regulations on the program of civic-patriotic and socially useful tourism “More than a trip”.⁸⁰

Vladimir Putin at the State Council Meeting, December 22, 2022:

“ I would like to emphasize that the substantive content of youth projects is of particular importance today. Currently, projects of educational focus are specifically important. Of course, there are instruments for that – thematic lessons at schools, clubs of additional education, in military-patriotic and history clubs. ... The “University sessions” project under the patronage of Russian higher education institutions has also successfully proven itself. ... And such formats should definitely be expanded. (note – author’s translation).⁸¹

The proposal to make the “University Sessions” project permanent and expand it for children from all regions of Russia (note – it also refers to the TOT of Ukraine) as a part of the development of youth patriotic tourism was submitted by the head of the State Council Commission on youth

policy, Dmitry Artyukhov, at the State Council meeting on December 22, 2022.⁸² In support of this proposal, Vladimir Putin issued the order No. Pr-173GS, dated January 29, 2023: to ensure the implementation of educational and tourism programs “University sessions” on the base of educational organizations of higher education with annual reporting.⁸³

During the preparation of the 2023 summer recreation campaign, the decision of the Presidium of the Council of Legislators of the Russian Federation at the Federal Assembly of the Russian Federation particularly states: The Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation in cooperation with the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation must improve the practice of conducting university profile educational sessions for children from the new subjects of the Russian Federation (*note – referred to the TOT of Ukraine*).⁸⁴

In 2023, the All-Russian public-state movement of children and youth “Movement of the First”, which was created and is governed by the federal law “On Russian Movement of Children and Youth”, became one of the organizers of “University sessions”.⁸⁵

Therefore, for the implementation of the “University sessions” project, the Russian Federation adopted new normative legal acts that regulate the activities of the newly created youth movements and organizations involved in the implementation of the project, which extend their activities to the TOT of Ukraine, contrary to the norms of international law.

4. STATISTICS – HOW MANY CHILDREN FROM THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES HAVE ALREADY PARTICIPATED?

In the period from June to September 2022, 6 sessions of 10 days each were held on the base of 42 institutions of higher education of the Russian Federation (a total of 89 sessions in all host universities), the participants of which were 11,458 persons from the TOT of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions, which included 10,611 children and about 842 accompanying persons.^{86, 87, 88}

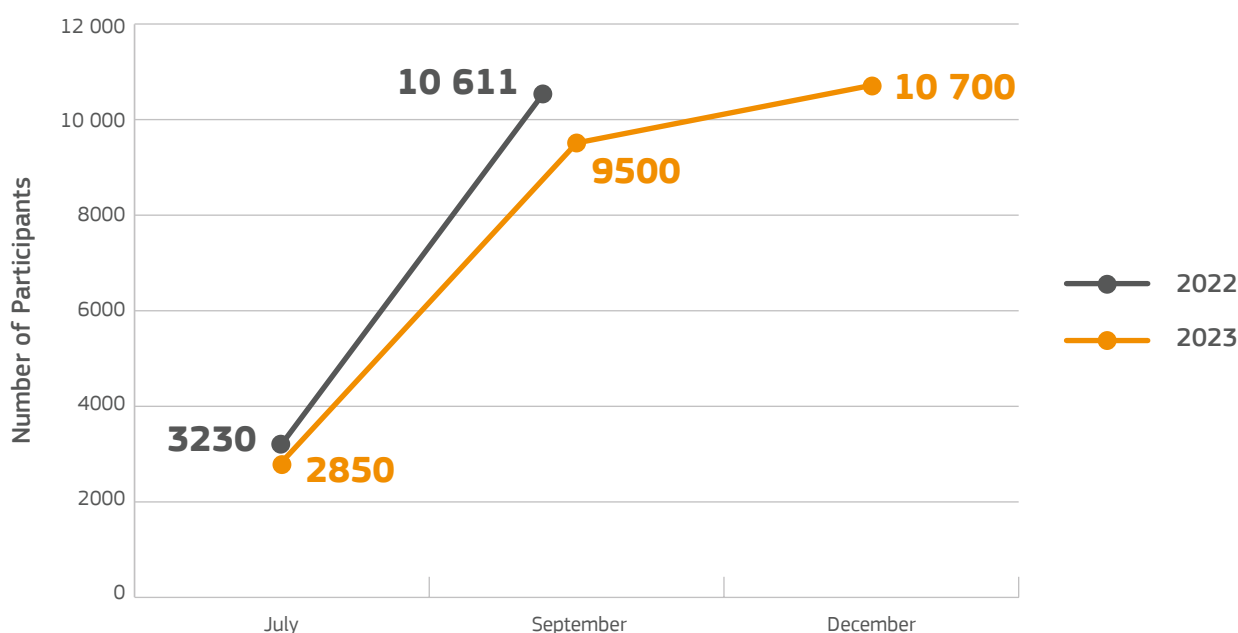

At the intermediate stage of the 2022 “University sessions”, namely, as a result of the completion of the first three sessions (as of July), the total number of participants was 3,230 persons.⁸⁹

In 2023, the scale-up of the project was announced, it was divided into 2 seasons: the spring season, in which almost 1,500 children took part, including 145 children from the TOT of Donetsk, Luhansk, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia regions; and the summer season. The planned total number of participants, according to the results of these stages exceeded 15,000 persons,⁹⁰ including 6,000 children from the so-called DPR, 3,000 from the so-called LPR, 1,100 from Kherson region, and 400 children from Zaporizhzhia region, who were planned to be involved.⁹¹

Dynamics of the Number of Students



*In 2022 the sessions ended in September.
Since 2023, the project is permanent.*

According to the results of the 2023 “University sessions”, the number of participants from the TOT of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions is almost the same as the previous year – about 10,700 schoolchildren. However, the number of institutions of higher education involved in the project has almost doubled – to 81 HEI from 47 subjects of the Russian Federation,⁹² of which about 50 are subordinate to the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, and 30 – to the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation.⁹³

During the intermediate stage of the sessions in 2023, the number of children from the TOT of Donetsk and Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions, who took part in three sessions (as of July) on the base of 21 HEI, amounted to more than 2,850 persons.⁹⁴

According to the results of 8 sessions (as of September) – more than 9,500 children from the TOT of Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions took part in the project on the base of 60 HEI from 8 federal districts of the Russian Federation.⁹⁵

Statistical data indicate the expansion of the network of subjects involved in the “University sessions” project, including the involvement of twice as many Higher Education Institutions in 2023, compared to 2022, which is a result of achieving goals of the pilot version of the project, which consisted of the formation of Russian identity among children through their Russification and erasure of Ukrainian consciousness. At that time, it was not possible to establish the reasons for the decrease in the number of participants from the open sources; according to the authors, this may be a result of the increase in the age of participants (from 12 to 14 years old), as well as the fear of parents to let children go to the territory of the Russian Federation after the numerous cases of non-return of children, who were taken on “recreation” in 2022.

5. FUNDING – WHO FINANCES THIS PROGRAM?

In 2022, the pilot project “University sessions” was financed by the Ministry of education of the Russian Federation and covered transporting, food, clothing etc.^{96, 97}

Direct payment for services (tourist excursion service, meals, souvenirs, branded products etc.) related to the organization and conducting the sessions was provided by the HEI by concluding contracts with providers of services.^{98, 99, 100}

It is impossible to establish the official amount of budget funds spent on the “University sessions” from open sources but taking into account the expenses of universities for each of the sessions, the average cost per participant is about 48,200 Rubles. Considering the total number of participants who took part in the “University sessions” in 2022, the estimated budget of the project was at least **552,275,600 Rubles**, which is approximately equivalent to **6,054,062 US Dollars**.

In 2023, including the implementation of the “University sessions” project into the “More than a trip” program, its financing is conducted within the framework of the federal project “Increasing the availability of tourism products” as a part of the state program of the Russian Federation “Development of tourism”. In accordance with the Order of the president of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin No. Pr-90, dated January 23, 2023, the main manager of budget funds required for the implementation of the mentioned program is the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs (Rosmolodyozh), and the sole operator of the Program is the Autonomous Non-commercial Organization “More than a trip”.¹⁰¹

The “More than a trip” program is a part of the presidential platform “Russia is a country of opportunities” and is implemented with the support of the All-Russian public and state movement of children and youth “Movement of the First”, the Russian society “Knowledge”, the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Culture of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, the Ministry of Economic Development of the Russian Federation and Rossotrudnichestvo (Federal Agency for the Commonwealth of Independent States Affairs, Compatriots Living Abroad, and International Humanitarian Cooperation).¹⁰²

In 2023, the budget of the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs amounted 69 billion Rubles, with a planned increase in expenses over the next three years to 188 billion Rubles.¹⁰³ That is, it is from these funds that the “University sessions” project is implemented with the support of, in particular, “Movement of the First”, a separate budget of which is more than 19 billion Russian Rubles.¹⁰⁴

II. ACTORS/FIGURES INVOLVED

1. RUSSIAN OFFICIALS WHO ARE INVOLVED

A number of officials of the Russian Federation, led by the President **Vladimir Putin**, are behind the creation and control of the “University sessions” project. It was on his orders that this project was created, it was extended and scaled up by presidential instructions.¹⁰⁵

The responsibility for the implementation of the Project lays on the Ministry of Science and Higher Education (headed by **Valery Falkov**,^{106, 107} the responsible person from the Ministry is **Grigory Gurov**¹⁰⁸ until December 2022, **Olga Petrova**^{109, 110, 111} since December 2022), the Ministry of Education (headed by **Sergey Kravtsov**,¹¹² responsible person from the Ministry – **Natalia Naumova**¹¹³), the Federal Agency on Youth Affairs (headed by **Ksenia Razuvayeva**),¹¹⁴ which are accountable and subordinate to the Government of the Russian Federation (headed by **Mihail Mishustin**),¹¹⁵ and it, in turn, is subordinate to the president, **Vladimir Putin**.

Organizations and movements additionally involved in the implementation of “University sessions” are:

- **All-Russian public and state educational organization “Russian Society “Knowledge”** (headed by **Maksim Dreval**),¹¹⁶
- **All-Russian social and state movement of children and youth “Movement of the First”** (headed by **Grigory Gurov**),¹¹⁷
- **ANO “Russia is a country of opportunities”** (headed by **Aleksey Komissarov**),¹¹⁸
- **ANO “More than a trip”** (headed by **Ivan Shuliupin** until October 2023,¹¹⁹ and by **Olesya Teterina** since October 3, 2023).¹²⁰

All the mentioned organizations and movements are united by the same scheme of creation and management – they were created at the initiative or decrees of the president Vladimir Putin, who continues to control them through the participation in their management bodies, which include the same officials of the Russian Federation, in particular, Valery Falkov, Sergey Kravtsov and Ksenia Razuvayeva.

Using their powers, the Central Ministries give instructions on the implementation of the “University sessions” project to lower-level federal and regional authorities, representatives of the occupation authorities in the TOT of Ukraine, as well as directly to the Higher Education Institutions involved in the organization of the sessions.

In particular, the following officials feature during the implementation of the sessions – regional Ministers of Education,¹²¹ representatives of regional bodies in the field of education,¹²² deputies of the State Duma of the Russian Federation,¹²³ federal offices of the human rights commissioner and others.¹²⁴

Such a system of relationships between officials with “independent” organizations and movements indicates that there are totalitarian methods of managing the youth policy of the Russian Federation in general, and the “University sessions” project in particular.

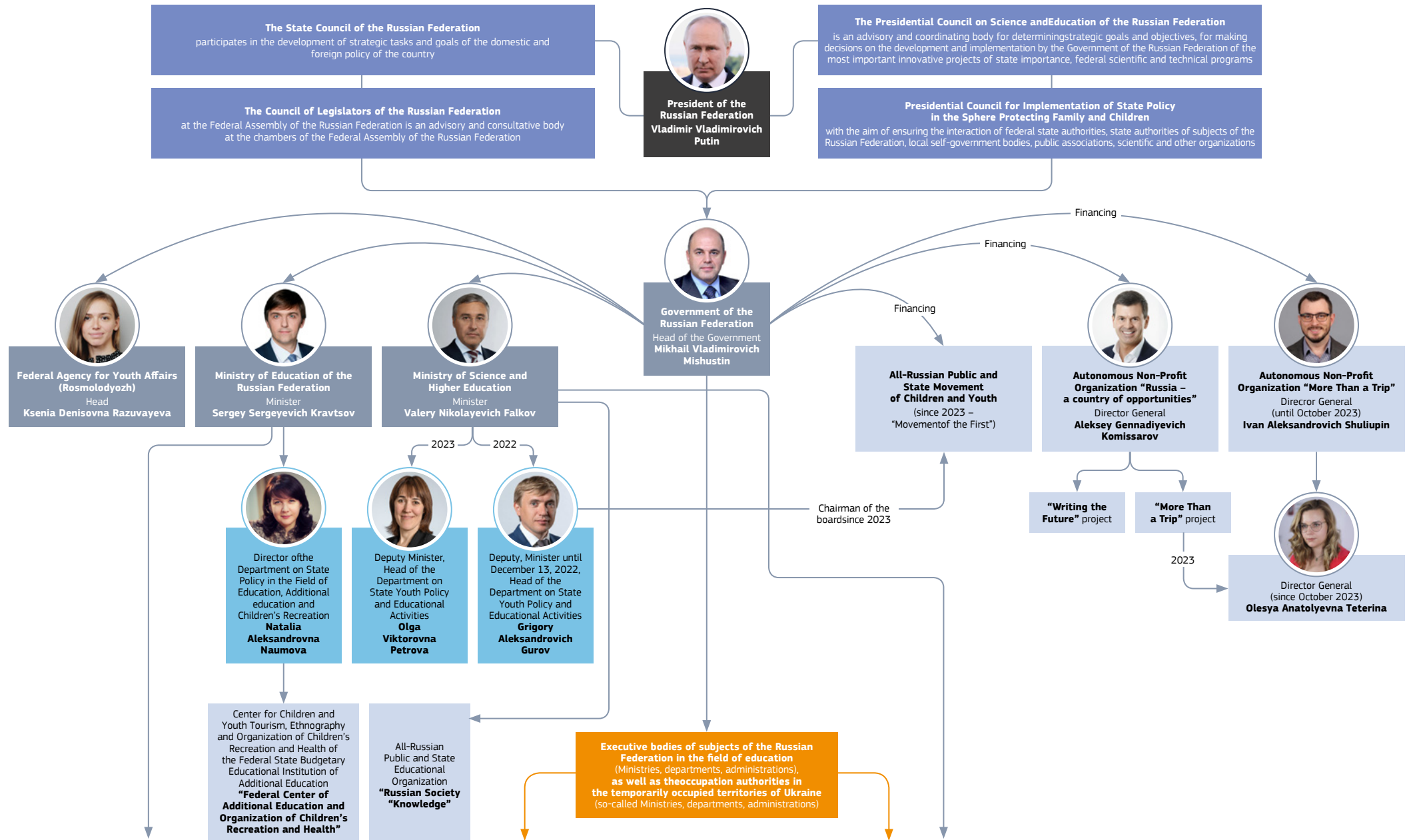

2. WHICH UNIVERSITIES CONDUCT/IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM?

Higher education institutions of the Russian Federation became the key executors of the project through the direct interaction of HEI employees and students with children from the TOT. In most universities, the vice-rectors for educational work were responsible for drafting the program, organizing, and carrying out the sessions. Children who came to the “University sessions” were grouped into squads, each of which had certain specialists assigned: a teacher, counselors (2–4-year students) and a psychologist. It should be noted that psychologists were constantly present with children, they took part in all the activities, held individual consultations, psychological testing, and also conducted psychological and pedagogical intervention. It was not possible to establish the content and the consequences of such intervention from the open sources, however, it is quite possible that psychological influence on children’s minds was carried out in order to achieve the goal of the project – the formation of Russian identity, which is de-facto Russification of Ukrainian children, erasure of their Ukrainian consciousness and stimulation of their relocation from the TOT to study and further residence in the Russian Federation. The confirmation of the stimulation of children’s relocation from the TOT to the territory of the Russian Federation is a **memo distributed to parents and legal representatives – it says about the migration to another country and the peculiarities of children’s adaptation while moving.**¹²⁵

According to the official data of the Russian authorities, in 2022, 42 higher education institutions from 27 subjects of the Russian Federation were involved in the implementation of the “University sessions” project.¹²⁶ Most of them, namely 30 HEI, had a pedagogical focus and were subordinate to the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation.¹²⁷

In 2023, the number of HEI involved in the implementation of the “University sessions” increased to 81 higher education institutions from 47 subjects of the Russian Federation,¹²⁸ about 50 of them are subordinate to the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, and 30 – to the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation.¹²⁹

Identified institutions of higher education are listed in [Annex 1](#) to this report.

On the official websites of 45 Higher Education Institutions involved in the “University sessions”, it is mentioned about the ongoing cooperation with international partners, in particular, with educational organizations and institutions of the countries of the European Union, United States

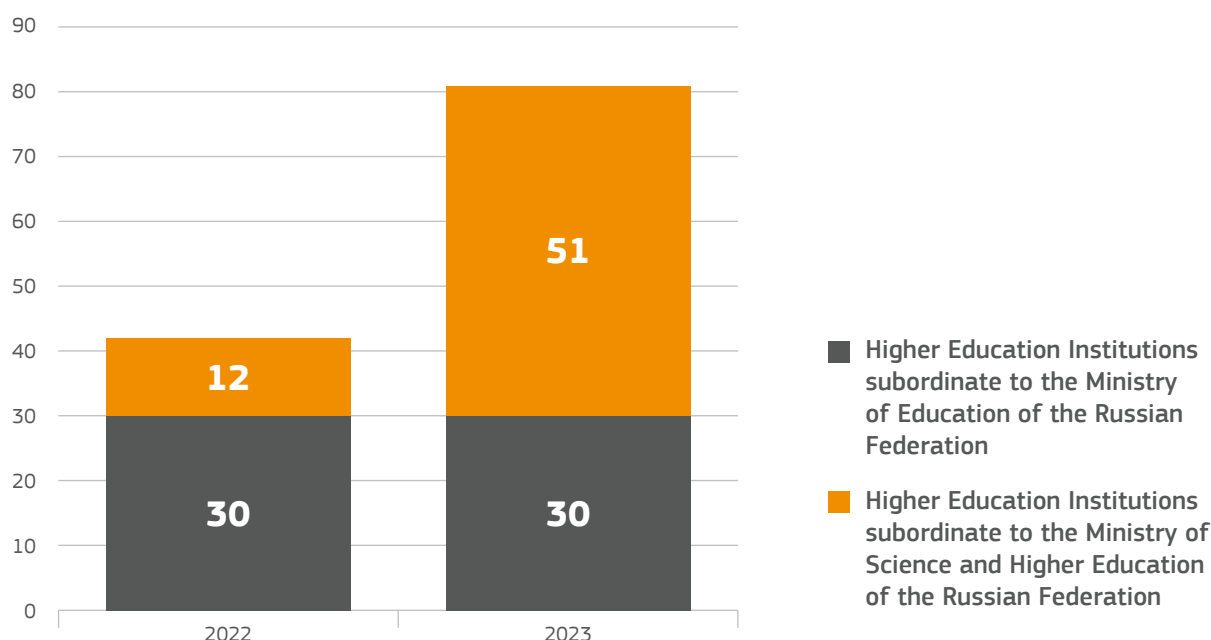

of America, Asia, China, Japan, Turkey, as well as continuation of the Erasmus+ student mobility programs. 18 websites of HEI do not contain information about international cooperation, which, in particular, is caused by the fulfillment of the requirements of the Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation No. 937, dated June 6, 2023, “On the suspension of clauses 11 and 14 of the Rules for placement on the official website of an educational organization in the information and telecommunications network “Internet” and updating information about the educational institution”, according to which the placement of information about the international cooperation is suspended until December 31, 2023. Therefore, the real international cooperation of the Higher Education Institutions of the Russian Federation can be much wider.

The involved universities became the main executors of the “University sessions” project, which directly interacted with children from the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine. By developing their own session programs, aimed at the formation of the Russian identity among children, they actually implemented the hidden goal of the project – the destruction of Ukrainian consciousness, and stimulation of children’s relocation from the occupied territories for studying and further residence in the Russian Federation.

3. OCCUPATION ADMINISTRATIONS – WHAT IS THEIR ROLE?

One of the links in the implementation of the “University sessions” project is the representatives of the occupation administrations of in the TOT of Ukraine. They are responsible for involvement of children in participation in the project. The practical implementation of the mechanism consists of sending to the educational institutions the information about the required number of participants,

terms, and directions for transferring children to the territory of the Russian Federation for the participation in the mentioned project, exercising control over its implementation, further reporting to the higher officials of the executive authorities of the Russian Federation.

Central persons from the occupation authorities in the TOT of Ukraine involved in the organization of the project are:

- The so-called Minister of Education and Science of the DPR – **Olga Koludarova**¹³⁰
- The so-called Minister of Education and Science of the LPR – **Ivan Kusov**^{131, 132}
- The so-called Minister of Education and Science of Zaporizhzhia region – **Elena Sharupova**¹³³
- The so-called Minister of Education of Kherson region – **Mikhail Rodikov** until February 2023¹³⁴, **Aleksey Galchenkov** until October 2023¹³⁵, **Lyudmila Kovtun** since October 2023¹³⁶
- The so-called Minister of Education, Science and Youth of the republic of Crimea – **Valentina Lavrik**¹³⁷
- The so-called Acting Head of the Department of Education and Science of the city of Sevastopol – **Maksim Krivonos**¹³⁸
- The so-called Head of the Government of DPR – **Vitaly Khotsenko**¹³⁹
- The so-called Deputy Chairman of the Government of the DPR – **Larisa Tolstykina**^{140, 141}
- The so-called Head of the Department of Education and Science of Kherson region – **Tatiana Kuzmich**¹⁴²

The mentioned persons, having started their collaborative activities in the occupying authorities, actually became one of the links in the organizational chain of the “University sessions” project, for which they should be held accountable, as well as officials of the Russian Federation – for violations of the norms of international law, which are committed during the implementation of this project.

4. RUSSIAN YOUTH MOVEMENTS

In 2023, the All-Russian public and state movement of children and youth “Movement of the First” (hereinafter referred to as “Movement of the First”) was involved in the organization of the spring and summer stages of the “University sessions” project, with the support of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education and the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation.^{143, 144}

“Movement of the first” is created and operates according to the Federal law No. 261-FZ, dated July 14, 2022, “On Russian movement of children and youth”.^{145, 146} The movement received its current name in December 2022.¹⁴⁷

The entire management of the “Movement of the First” is actually carried out personally by the president of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin, since he is the one who heads the Supervisory Board of the “Movement of the First”, which operated indefinitely, and he personally approves and changes its composition.¹⁴⁸ The Supervisory Board includes, in particular, a number of officials – the Minister of Education of the Russian Federation S. Kravtsov, the Minister of Science and Higher Education V. Falkov, the Presidential Commissioner for Children’s Rights M. Lvova-Belova, the Head of the Federal Agency on Youth Affairs K. Razuvayeva, the Deputy Head of the Government of the Russian Federation T. Golikova.¹⁴⁹ The Supervisory Board, in turn, forms the Coordination Council, who have the right to make decisions on the creation and liquidation of regional branches of the Movement, determines the composition of the councils of regional branches of the Movement and appoints their heads, as well as determines the personal composition of the Management Board of the Movement. The Chairman of the Board, who is the sole executive body of the Movement and manages the current activities of the Movement, is also appointed personally by the president of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin.¹⁵⁰ Grigory Gurov, who until December 2022 held the position of the Deputy Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation and was the responsible person from the Ministry for the implementation of the “University sessions” project in 2022, was appointed as the Chairman of the Board of the “Movement of the First”.¹⁵¹

One of the activities of the “Movement of the First” is “patriotism and historical memory “Serve the Fatherland!” the idea of which is “members of the Movement are united with the Fatherland by one destiny. Everyone in one’s place prepares oneself for serving the Fatherland

and responsibility for its future” (*note – author’s translation*).¹⁵² As a part of this activity, support is provided to servicemen of the Russian Federation who are fighting in the territory of Ukraine, children get involved in making trench candles for them, weaving camouflage nets, they are taught how to build and operate drones, and military-patriotic games are held.

The organization of the All-Russian project “University sessions” throughout the year is defined as one of the activities for children and youth, implemented by the “Movement of the First in 2023”.¹⁵³

As a part of this project, among the tasks of the “Movement of the First” there were the development and the implementation of programs aimed at ensuring civic-patriotic education of underaged students and popularizing the activities of the movement. “University sessions” were conventionally divided into two types: the first were carried out by the “Movement of the First”, one of conditions for the participation in which was membership in the movement and registration on the Movement’s official website;¹⁵⁴ the second – without the mandatory membership in the Movement, however the program included a day dedicated to the “Movement of the First”. In both cases representatives of the Movement held meetings with children, spoke about the prospects of the membership in the “Movement of the First,” and campaigned for new children to join.

“Movement of the First” became one of the instruments used by Russia to upbringing convenient youth and destroy Ukrainian consciousness of children from the TOT of Ukraine, and the “University sessions” project became a convenient platform for this, promoting the ideas of the “Movement of the First” and inviting children to join it.

5. OTHER ACTORS

One of the actors involved in the implementation of “University sessions” is the All-Russian public and state educational organization “Russian society “Knowledge.”

The Russian society “Knowledge” is a public non-commercial organization that conducts educational work, formation of intellectual content, organization and conducting free lectures, as well as various events in the field of education. One of the main goals of the society is cultivation of patriotism among the younger generation, strengthening of international unity, fighting against “false science” and “falsification of history”.¹⁵⁵ It is noteworthy that this society resumed its work in 2021 at the behest of the president V. Putin according to the proposal of Maksim Dreval, who later became the head of this society.^{156, 157}

The role of the “Knowledge” society in the “University sessions” project is to hold lectures and military-patriotic educational events for children, based on the society’s goals to cultivate patriotism and fight against the “falsification of history.” In fact, during such lectures, children receive information about the exaltation of Russia, the period of the Great Patriotic War is heroized and romanticized, parallels are drawn with the war in the territory of Ukraine, and they are also told about the “return of territories” (*note – referred to the TOT of Ukraine*).^{158, 159, 160}

The Center for Children and Youth’s Tourism, Ethnography and the Organization of Children’s Recreation and Health, which is a part of the FSBEI AE “Federal center for additional education and organization of children’s recreation and health” created by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, is involved in training of personnel for the implementation of “University sessions”.¹⁶¹ The center prepared a series of webinars, in which it is told about the observance of mandatory elements in the organization of sessions, such as the use of Russian symbols (daily raising of the flag of the Russian Federation to the anthem of the Russian Federation etc.), the holding of a series of educational events “Conversations about the important” on 18 topics (“Brotherhood of the Slavic Peoples”, “Sanction War”, “About Military Correspondents”,

“Historical Truth” and others).^{162, 163, 164, 165, 166} Separate webinars are dedicated to the “peculiarities of the organization of psychological and pedagogical support for underaged children who came from the territories of DPR, LPR and Ukraine”, which contain information about the rules for handling children, in particular, on examples of psychological suffering of children taken from the territory of Ukraine to children’s camps in the Russian Federation.^{167, 168}

The recommendations contained in the mentioned webinars indicate the pre-developed and organized mechanism of transferring children from the TOT of Ukraine for further psychological work on them in order to destroy their Ukrainian identity and persuade them to “love Russia”. The executors of this process are the extensive system of state bodies of the Russian Federation and organizations subordinate to them, including the “Russian society “Knowledge” and the Center for Children and Youth’s Tourism, Ethnography and Organization of Children’s Recreation and Health.

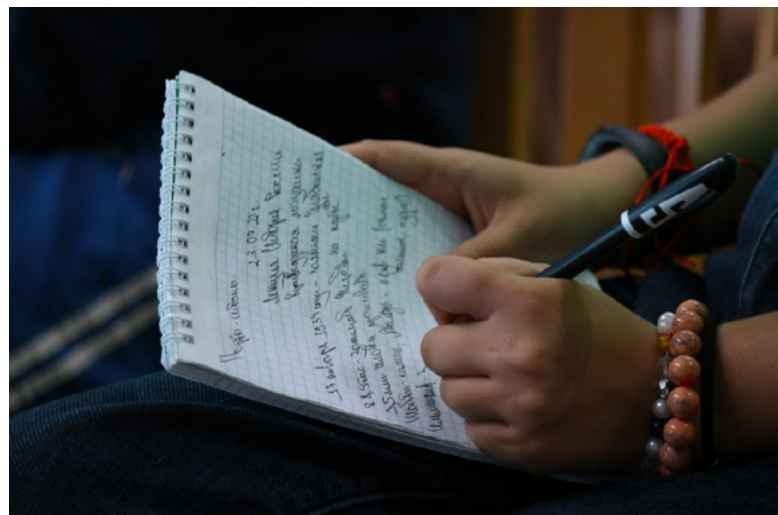

III. CONTENT OF THE PROGRAM

Each higher education institution that accepted children for “University sessions” developed its own session program, designed for a 10day stay of children, which had its own name, **but should consist of six mandatory modules: educational, cultural and patriotic, professional, sports, excursion, and recreational.**¹⁶⁹

The educational module was 32 hours, upon completion of which children received a certificate.^{170, 171}

► **The educational module** was aimed at learning history and culture of Russia, and depending on the University, the module could have the following names: “History of Russia in the mirror of culture” (conducted by Omsk State Pedagogical University), “Heritage of Russia” (Armavir State Pedagogical University), “Russia’s Pride” (Perm State Humanitarian Pedagogical University), “Russia’s Feat” (Volgograd State Socio-Pedagogical University), “A Date with Russia: New Horizons. Following the Routes of Tomsk” (Tomsk State Pedagogical University) and similar ones.¹⁷² As a part of these directions, mandatory lectures on the following topics were held: “History of Russia”, “History of the Culture of the Peoples of Russia”, “Victory of Great People”, dedicated to the Russian Language Day, Day of the National Flag of the Russian Federation, lessons on the history of Russia and Donbas, etc.¹⁷³

Children had to take notes of all the lecture material, which is the additional way to impose the perception of information.

The goals of the development of programs with such a focus are the formation of children’s positive attitude towards Russia, the erasure of Ukrainian identity, and instead the **education of them as patriots of Russia with the values, views, orientations, attitudes, motives of activity and behavior necessary for the Russian government**. The pursuit of hidden goals in the implementation of the programs is the comment of the scientist of the South Ural

State Humanitarian Pedagogical University, who conducted an interactive lecture “Cultivation of citizenship in the history of Russia” for children from the TOT:

“ *In the process of inculcating patriotism, it is important for children to know and understand the origins... people begin to associate themselves with certain territory, endowing this land with meanings important for them. This is later transformed into the concepts of statehood and citizenship (note – author’s translation).*¹⁷⁴

▶ **The cultural and patriotic module** included, in particular, events that have signs of manipulation of concepts, distortion of historical events, romanticization of war, and heroization of military personnel participating in war against Ukraine:

- As a part of the “Through the pages of the Russia’s history” session, Shadrinsk State Pedagogical University held a meeting with the scientist who told children about German Nazism and drew parallels with “Ukrainian Nazism.” During this conversation he emphasized “the tradition of the succession, courage, selflessness and self-sacrifice of modern warriors in the fight against Ukrainian Nazism during the Special Military Operation” (*note – author’s translation, the term “modern warriors” refers to servicemen of the Russian Federation, who are fighting against Ukraine*).¹⁷⁵
- Tambov State University named after G. R. Derzhavin held a military-patriotic game “Zarnitsa” for children from the TOT, during which children are taught to shoot weapons, simulate the conditions of a military battlefield, and perform other tasks of a militaristic nature.^{176,177}

- Ufa University of Science and Technology involved children from the TOT, who were participants of “University sessions,” in taking military oath by students of the higher education institution.¹⁷⁸
- Also, Ufa University of Science and Technology held lecture for children on the topic “Crimea and Malorossiya: a long way home”, which is an example of the distortion of historical events, presenting the Russian occupation of the territories of Ukraine under the guise of their return and at the same time heroizing the actions of the Russian Federation. Also, the thematic evening “I am a citizen of my country” was held (*note – referred to the Russian Federation*).¹⁷⁹
- At the Kozma Minin Nizhny Novgorod State Pedagogical University, employees of the educational center for patriotic education “Gvardeyets” worked with children throughout the session (*which is a structural division of the State Budgetary Education “Nizhny Novgorod Cadet Corps of the Volga Federal District named after Army General V. F. Margelov”, main goal is patriotic education of youth and preparation for military service*).¹⁸⁰
- Glazov State Pedagogical Institute named after V. G. Korolenko held a screening of the film “Kalashnikov” for children (*note – Russian military-biographic film about the inventor of the AK-47 assault rifle Mikhail Kalashnikov*), held a “brain-ring” game called “War Lessons”, as well as organized meetings of children with soldiers

of the student law enforcement detachment “Sirius” and the Battle Brotherhood, where children were taught self-defense techniques.¹⁸¹

▶ Some representatives of Higher Education Institutions define the **Professional module** as the main one in carrying out specific sessions, saying that “having put the main emphasis on career guidance, they hope that after graduating from schools many children will enter their university”.¹⁸² At the Kuban State University, the program was aimed specifically at career guidance, according to the results of which a schoolgirl from the TOT of Zaporizhzhia region says:

“ I really liked it here, I even thought about enrolling here (note – referred to Kuban State University). The program was eventful, there was absolutely no time for rest (note – author’s translation).¹⁸³

During the sessions, career guidance work with children was conducted by universities using various instruments, for example, in I. Ya. Yakovlev Chuvash State Pedagogical University – with the help of the “World of Professions” tour,¹⁸⁴ Saratov State Pedagogical University held career guidance lectures, tests, experiments in laboratories, excursions, and presentations of the material-technical equipment of the university.¹⁸⁵

Confirmation of the effectiveness of the career guidance activities for the stimulation of admission to Russian HEI is the comment of the participant of “University sessions” at the Yaroslavl State Pedagogical University named after K.D. Ushinsky, a student of 10th grade from the TOT, the city of Horlivka:

“ *It was the first time I visited “University sessions” ... During the session I understood that now I will definitely go to pedagogy, and not to law as my mother wanted. I really want to enter a pedagogical university and become an elementary school teacher or a teacher of Russian Language and Literature (note – author’s translation).*¹⁸⁶

▶ **The sports module** includes competitions and games, which, in particular, have historical focus, popularize Russian culture, which contributes to the achievement of the project’s goal – Russification of children from the temporarily occupied territories. Among the activities that were held in this module, the following can be distinguished: children’s participation in the obstacle course “Sports and I – Hooray to Physical Education”, orienteering, sports event “Sports of the World”.¹⁸⁷ Tomsk State Pedagogical University held the sports game “Records of Victory”. According to its rules, children go through the chain of stations and familiarize themselves with facts from the history of the Great Patriotic War. After learning the quantitative indexes from the history, children need to perform exercises – jumping, pull-ups, sit-ups, and others. According to the organizers, the game is aimed not only at sports competition, but it is also for the “fixation of facts of historical truth” (note – author’s translation).¹⁸⁸ In Kuban State University, the passing of standards of the “Ready for Labor and Defense” discipline was organized for children, and the results were added to personal accounts on the official website.¹⁸⁹

▶ **The excursion module** in each university is designed taking into account the theme of the session and is actually aimed at the destruction of children’s Ukrainian identity by imposing on them the idea of positioning themselves as Russians, and it is also aimed at the popularization of the Russian Federation, Russian culture, language, symbols, etc.

The comments of university representatives confirm this:

“ *As part of the excursion module, children learned about the origins of the Russian statehood, about the Vladimir-Suzdal land as a spiritual pillar of Russia. **These activities are aimed at forming a spiritual, moral and patriotic attitude to the history and culture of Russia, acquiring the competences of intercultural communication and the new socio-cultural experience and knowledge about national traditions of the Russian world** (note – author’s translation).*¹⁹⁰

Examples of conducted activities of the excursion module:

- The representatives of South Ural State University of Humanities and Pedagogy held an interactive exhibition in the “Russia – My History” park for the participants of the sessions, which manipulates children’s perception of Russia as “their own”.¹⁹¹
- Shadrinsk State Pedagogical Institute organized a trip to the city of Kurgan for the children from the TOT, which was dedicated to the “Russia Day.” As part of the trip, participants visited the festival of Slavic and Cossack culture “Russian Field,” where children learned and sang the national anthem of the Russian Federation.¹⁹²
- As a part of the program “Nizhny Novgorod – the Heritage of Russia,” Kozma Minin Nizhny Novgorod State Pedagogical University organized a trip to Balakhna, to a historical multimedia park “Russia – My History,” a visit to Technopark, an excursion to Kremlin.¹⁹³
- Vladimir State University held a series of educational tours in a virtual format: children were shown the city of Vladimir in the years of war, the cities of the

“Golden Ring,” and small towns of Russia with the aim of “approaching the originally Russian culture and spiritual values of Russia.”¹⁹⁴

- As a part of the “Russia’s Feat” session at the Volgograd State Socio-Pedagogical University, children went on excursions to the “Battle of Stalingrad” and “Russia – My History” museums, they climbed the “the main height of Russia – Mamayev Kurgan.”¹⁹⁵
- Children became participants of the thematic meeting with the manipulative name “Be with Russia” at the I. Ya. Yakovlev Chuvash State Pedagogical University.¹⁹⁶



The recreational module, despite its name, also contains elements of propaganda and the imposition of Russian narratives:

- At the South Ural State University of Humanities and Pedagogy, on the final day of the “University session,” children took part in the “Russian World” game and the activities of the “Great Change” project of the Russian movement of schoolchildren.¹⁹⁷

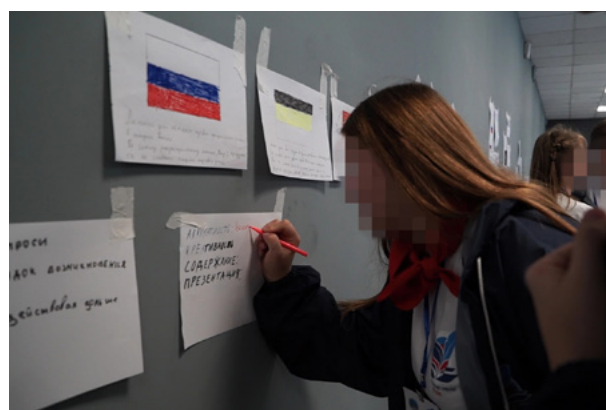

- Representatives of the Saratov Chernyshevsky State University cynically invite children from the TOT to participate in the rally-concert “Your home – Russia!”, organized for the “Day of the Re-unification of Donetsk and Luhansk People’s Republics, Zaporizhzhia and Kherson regions with Russia” (*note – the day of the so-called “accession” of the TOT of Ukraine to the Russian Federation*).¹⁹⁸
- Shadrinsk State Pedagogical University held a quiz “State Symbols of Russia,” in which children were given information about the official and unofficial symbols of Russia, history of Donbass in a playful form, which cannot be considered a casual recreation.¹⁹⁹

- Lipetsk State Pedagogical University named after Pyotr Semyonov-Tyan-Shansky held a master class for children on folk (*note - Russian*) songs and a historical quest “Deeds of Peter the Great”.²⁰⁰
- Tomsk State Pedagogical University held an intellectual game “My Russia – My homeland” for children from the TOT. The name of the game imposes the idea of children’s affiliation with Russia, manipulates their identity, instills Russian narratives in a playful way.²⁰¹
- For children participating in “University sessions”, Ilya Ulyanov State Pedagogical University holds, in particular, such games as “Guess the Song”, detective game “Intelligence school”, “Around the World”, “Sleuths”, “Country-meter”, “Encyclopedia”, “Trip around Russia”, “Trip around the world”. According to the organizers, all games are aimed at familiarizing children with the history of Russia and its culture.²⁰²

In addition to educational activities aimed at the Russification and indoctrination of children, symbols of the Russian Federation are widely used during the “University sessions” (implemented based on the Methodological recommendations of the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation, dated April 15, 2022, “On the use of state symbols of the Russian Federation in education and upbringing of children and youth in educational organizations, as well as organizations for children’s recreation and health”)²⁰³ – the opening and closing of each session was held with the raising of the flag of the Russian Federation and to the sound of the national anthem of the Russian Federation, all souvenir products provided to children were branded in colors of the Russian Flag.^{204, 205, 206}

CONCLUSIONS

The “University sessions” project, introduced by the Russian Federation for children from the TOT of Ukraine, is the instrument for destroying the Ukrainian identity of children, re-educating them into “patriots of Russia” and creating the illusory picture of the potential future exclusively with the Russian Federation. Based on the collected evidence, it can be stated that the system of the implementation of the “University sessions” project is planned in advance – from the executors involved (Movement of the First, “Knowledge” Society, which are under control of the authorities and have a military-patriotic orientation among other areas of activity) to the programs of the sessions (which were developed with mandatory basing on the patriotic component, included lectures on the fight against “Ukrainian Nazism”, glorification of military personnel of the Russian Federation who are fighting against Ukraine, popularized Russian culture, state symbols, distorted historical facts, etc.). With this project, the Russian Federation implements a plan to form a mobilization reserve of children and youth for the continuation of the war against Ukraine. Whereas by forming a positive attitude towards the aggressor state, creating conditions when the admission to the Russian higher education institutions is beneficial and has no alternatives, Russia de-facto imposes on children the self-identification as the Russians and the idea of further relocation to the territory of Russia for permanent residence. As the additional factor, children upon reaching the age of 14 are subject to another crime – enforced passporting, which entails the obligation to serve in the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation and children can potentially be sent to fight against Ukraine. All these actions of the Russian Federation, which radically change the educational system in the occupied territories, relocate children from the TOT (which happens during the “University sessions”) are a gross violation of the norms of International Humanitarian Law, a violation of the rules of the occupation regime established by the Hague Rules, the Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of the Civilian Population, as well as customary norms of the Humanitarian Law, which severely limit the powers of the occupier state and establish the right of the residents of the occupied territories to maintain a normal life without significant interference from the temporary occupation administrations. By implementing the projects aimed at actually re-educating Ukrainian children and raising them to become “true Russians,” the Russian Federation disregards the norms of International Human Rights Law, in particular, depriving children of the opportunity to preserve their own Ukrainian identity. This very aspect of re-education, which in particular instrumentalizes informal education and leisure, is the key one and requires a proper response for the immediate termination and guarantees of non-repetition. In view of the seriousness of the violations, the facts of the expansion of the project and its transformation into a permanent one, it is necessary to bring to justice all those involved in order to stop the activity of this and similar projects in the future.

Since the beginning of the armed aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine, the education system turned into a political instrument, the purpose of which is to change a worldview of people who ended up in the occupation. The Russian authorities pay special attention to the “re-education” of children and youth in order to form loyal “Russian citizens” in the occupied territories, who will not have historical memory and will not be a threat to the occupation regime. Thus, in his presidential decrees, V. Putin positions patriotic education as one of the main means

for achieving the strategic goals of the Russian Federation.²⁰⁷ For example, at the congress of young scientists that took place on November 28-30, 2023, in the “Sirius” federal territory, Vladimir Putin stated:

“ *Russia needs to gain a foothold in the new territories not only through military and political means, but also in working with people, so that they understood the advantage of the accession to the Russian Federation.*²⁰⁸

As is known, it is education that transforms and directs the life of society, preserving everything that has value for people in it; determines the strategy and realistic condition for the development of society, transforming it from “society of today” into “society of tomorrow”, forms a new mindset of citizens, a new vision of the meaning of life.

The data of the analytical report indicate *that the system of higher education of the Russian Federation and the academic community of Russian universities are actively involved in the implementation of the Kremlin’s military and hybrid efforts* – not only to seize the territory of the sovereign state of Ukraine and restore its own sphere of influence in the Eastern Europe, but also to destroy the unity, weaken and discredit the multilateral institutions of the democratic world, primarily the EU and NATO. Since it was the Ukraine’s movement in the direction of integration into the specified that was used by the Russian Federation as a formal pretext for starting full-scale hostilities against Ukraine.²⁰⁹

Based on the collected evidence, it can be stated that the system of implementation of “University sessions” project was planned in advance – from the executors involved (Movement of the First, “Knowledge” Society, which are under control of the authorities and have a military-patriotic orientation among other areas of activity) to the programs of the sessions (which were developed with mandatory basing on the patriotic component, included lectures on the fight against “Ukrainian Nazism”, glorification of military personnel of the Russian Federation who are fighting against Ukraine, popularized Russian culture, state symbols, distorted historical facts, etc.).

With this project, the Russian Federation implements a plan to form a mobilization reserve of children and youth for the continuation of the war against Ukraine. Violations related to education can also have important social consequences, namely the manipulation of education for political purposes affects not only individuals, but also communities and societies. The consequences of abuse associated with the development of a culture of violence and impunity can have a long-term impact on the social patterns of memories. As Gail Weldon said, the past of the conflict “not only forms the way in which the new social order is planned, but also the ways in which painful knowledge is transmitted from generation to generation”²¹⁰ thus contributing to the potential recurrence of hatred and violence.

That is why the joint efforts of the Ukrainian authorities, civil society, the Ukrainian and international academic community, and international institutions to stop the practice of using education for war crimes and cultural genocide are important.

Considering the impact and damage caused by the “University sessions” program in general, and the Russian universities involved in it in particular, in order to protect Ukrainian children who are currently in occupation, the following actions are necessary:

- Complete termination of any international cooperation with Russian universities, which engage in the implementation of the “University sessions” program, as well as with rectors of the specified universities, professors, and scientists.
- Prohibition of the participation of universities and their representatives, in particular students and scientists involved in the implementation of the “University sessions” program, in such international programs as Erasmus+ and European Business School.
- Bring to justice representatives of the Russian academic community and officials who are executors of the mentioned practices, in particular by including them on the sanctions list of the EU and individual countries.
