The list of persons and universities proposed for inclusion in the sanctions list due to the facts of their implementation of the program for the russification of Ukrainian children from the temporarily occupied territories – “University sessions.”



SANCTIONS



“UNIVERSITY SESSIONS”

(Russ. – “Universitetskiye smeny”) is a program held on the campuses of Russian universities for children from the temporarily occupied territories aged 12-17, during sessions ten days each.

The objective of the program is career guidance and the formation of the Russian identity, and de-facto – the russification of Ukrainian children, the erasure of Ukrainian identity and the stimulation of their relocation from the occupied territories to study and further residence in the Russian Federation.

The transferring of Ukrainian children from the temporarily occupied territories (hereinafter – TOT) for participation in such program contradicts international law, in particular, the 1989 Convention on the Rights of a Child, Art. 49 of the Geneva Convention relative to the Protection of Civilian Persons in Time of War, Art. 43 of the Hague Regulations.

FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "SARATOV CHERNYSHEVSKY STATE UNIVERSITY"

Application-oriented research of university scientists is used in the defense sector of the Russian Federation. In 2022-2023, Saratov State University held numerous events supporting the so-called "Special Military Operation" and the President of Russia, Vladimir Putin.

THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 20,141 students (in 2022), of which 2,042 are in colleges of Saratov State University (hereinafter - SSU)

RECTOR: **Aleksey Nikolayevich Chumachenko**

He was born on October 24, 1960, in the Ukrainian USSR, in the village of Olenivka, Perevalsk Raion, Voroshylovhrad region (currently, it is the TOT of Luhansk region). He is a supporter of the war started by Russia against Ukraine (the so-called "Special Military Operation") – in March 2022, he was one of those rectors who, in their address, supported the war and Russian President Vladimir Putin. In addition, Chumachenko openly speaks about such support on his page in the VKontakte social network on behalf of the SSU. By the decree of the President of Ukraine, dated June 9, 2022, No. 401/2022, sanctions were imposed on Saratov State University and its rector Aleksey Nikolayevich Chumachenko.



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

In 2023, Saratov State University took part in the "University Sessions" program for the first time:

In the period from September 26 to October 5, 2023, **48 high school students from Donetsk and Mariupol were accommodated in the "Berizka" camp (Russ. "Beryozka") and on the base of SSU.** Under the guise of educational and leisure activities, activities that glorify everything Russian, impose Russian culture and propagandistic version of historical events distorted by Russia and justifying the illegal accession of Ukrainian territories to the Russian Federation are organised for Ukrainian children.

ILLEGAL INTEGRATION OF OCCUPIED EDUCATION INTO THE RUSSIAN EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM:

The cooperation of SSU with higher education institutions in the TOT of the Luhansk Region was recorded on January 13, 2023, with the signing of an agreement on scientific and educational cooperation in the temporarily occupied city of Luhansk, which aims to integrate into the Russian educational system. As a part of such cooperation, in March 2023, a delegation from the so-called Luhansk State Pedagogical University visited SSU to take part in the Tenth Scientific and Educational Festival "Pedagogical Education Week", and already in September 2023, students of Luhansk University began distance learning at SSU according to the program of professional retraining of the "Digital Department" project.



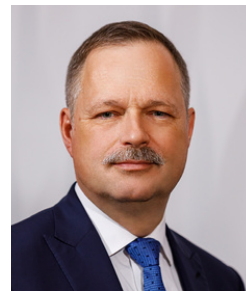
FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "BAUMAN MOSCOW STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY" (HEREINAFTER - BMSTU)

BMSTU is a university that is considered one of the most authoritative in the Russian Federation. The activities of BMSTU, including the implementation of "University sessions," are an example for other educational institutions of the Russian Federation and the scientific community to follow. The university also declares existing international cooperation under 113 concluded agreements, including with European states.

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: more than 31,000 students and postgraduates.

RECTOR: **Mikhail Valeriyevich Gordin.**

He openly supports the war against Ukraine and the policies that threaten the territorial integrity of Ukraine – he signed an appeal in support of the actions of the President of the Russian Federation regarding the full-scale armed invasion of Ukraine, for which on June 9, 2022, Ukraine imposed sanctions on Mikhail Gordin and BMSTU, and on November 2, 2023, the USA also imposed sanctions on BMSTU.



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

During the "University Sessions" held at Bauman Moscow State Technical University since 2022, children engage in participation in cultural, educational, propagandistic, militaristic, and other events. In particular:

- The Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, Valery Falkov, held a meeting with children from the so-called Luhansk People's Republic (hereinafter - LPR) and Donetsk People's Republic (hereinafter - DPR) at Bauman Moscow State Technical University, where he spoke about preferential conditions for admission to Russian higher education institutions for children from the TOT of Ukraine.
- For children displaced from the TOT of Ukraine, the University profile session "Engineers create the future" was held, where children were encouraged to study at the BMSTU.

COOPERATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF DEFENSE OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION, EVENTS IN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

- BMSTU conducts training of specialists of the Main Research and Testing Center for Robotics of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation according to the program "Designing terrestrial robots for special purposes."
- Conducts training of officers of the radio engineering troops, including for the participation in the war against Ukraine.
- Conducts training of students in defined specialities under the condition that students sign contracts for further work in the structural divisions of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation after graduation, as well as the possibility of concluding a contract for military service.
- BMSTU conducts developments for military personnel, presented at the "Army-2022" military-technical forum.



FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "PLEKHANOV RUSSIAN UNIVERSITY OF ECONOMICS" (HEREINAFTER - PRUE)

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

more than 26,000 students.

RECTOR:

Ivan Vasilyevich Lobanov

He openly supports the war against Ukraine and the policies that threaten the territorial integrity of Ukraine, for which, on October 19, 2022, Ukraine imposed personal sanctions on him. Since 2004, Lobanov has been a pro-government political party "United Russia" member.



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

Since 2022, as a part of "University sessions", PRUE organised:

- A thematic evening, "I am a citizen of Russia", for children from the TOT of the Luhansk region, which was de-facto aimed at replacing Ukrainian identity with Russian.
- For children from the TOT, team games, trainings and sports relays were held, as well as sight-seeing tours of Moscow, including trips to "RosCosmos" (Roscosmos State Corporation for Space Activities) and "Patriot" park. Such activities are aimed at imposing respect for the history of the Russian Federation, trying to adapt children from the TOT to the realities of being a "citizen of the Russian Federation."
- PRUE organised days dedicated to the All-Russian Public and State Movement of Children and Youth "Movement of the First" (Russ. "Dvizheniye Pervykh") for children from the TOT, during which they popularised this movement, spoke about the prospects of membership in the "Movement of the First" and campaigned to join it. One of the directions of the "Movement of the First" activities is "patriotism and historical memory "Serve the Fatherland," the idea of which is: "All members of the movement are united with the Fatherland (in a given context – the Russian Federation) by one destiny. Everyone is in their own place, preparing to serve the Russian Federation and be responsible for its future."
- A meeting was held with the Deputy Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Russian Federation, Olga Petrova, who told children about the conditions for admission to Russian higher education institutions and projects implemented in Russia for children, including children from the TOT.

OFFICIAL AND OPEN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

PRUE openly supports the war of the Russian Federation against Ukraine organizes campaigns in support of participants of the so-called "Special Military Operation"

- A military training centre was opened at the base of PRUE.
- PRUE actively supports and develops a military-patriotic movement of youth – an agreement was concluded with the militaristic organisation All-Russian Military-Patriotic Public Movement of Children and Youth "Young Army" ("Yunarmiya"). Also, they concluded an agreement with the so-called DonNUET named after Mykhailo Tuhon-Baranovskiy (in the TOT of Donetsk region) on the creation of a joint R&D centre of a distributed type of unmanned aircraft systems (hereinafter - UAS) of the rotor and aircraft type (for use for military purposes, including in the war against Ukraine).



FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "SHADRINSK STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY" (HEREINAFTER – SHSPU)

ShSPU promotes the Russian language abroad, in particular, in 2023, agreements/memorandums on cooperation were signed with the Republic of Seychelles and the Republic of Madagascar, and on May 29, 2023, the educational courses "Russian Fairy Tale" and "Russian Cuisine" started at the Open Education Center of the Ministry of Education of Russia in the Republic of Madagascar

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

3,350 students.

RECTOR:

Artur Ruslanovich Dziov

In 2021, Dziov submitted his application to the State Duma of the Russian Federation as a candidate for participation in the preliminary voting from the pro-presidential party "United Russia". He officially states that children from the temporarily occupied Luhansk, who were brought to the "University sessions," should understand "that this (meaning Russia) is their historical homeland, and they are at home here."



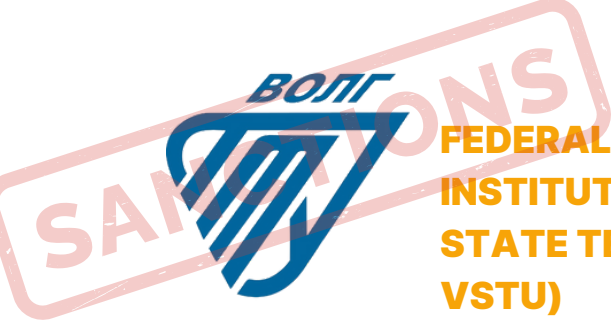
RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

ShSPU became the first university in the Russian Federation to host children from the TOT of Luhansk and Donetsk regions in the period from June 6 to June 15, 2022, under the "University sessions" program, as a part of which the following activities were held for children:

- Cultural and patriotic events, with signs of manipulation of concepts, distortion of historical events, romanticisation of war, and heroisation of military personnel participating in the war against Ukraine, in particular, during the events where children were told about German Nazism, parallels with "Ukrainian Nazism" were drawn.
- A quiz "State symbols of Russia" – children were given information about the official and unofficial symbols, history of Russia and Donbass in a playful form.
- Excursion activities that force children to position themselves as Russians, and are also aimed at popularising the Russian Federation, Russian culture, language, symbols etc. – a trip to the city of Kurgan, dedicated to the "Russia Day," where Ukrainian children learned and sang the national anthem of the Russian Federation.

OFFICIAL AND OPEN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

- In 2022, a permanent exhibition "Heroes of Special Operation Z" was organised at ShSPU, which tells about Russian servicemen of the so-called military operation in Ukraine.
- ShSPU takes an active part in helping the military personnel of the Russian Federation, involving students who sell used books, and funds raised are sent to the special account of the units of the so-called DPR Army; in 2023, ShSPU in cooperation with the "People's Front" collected things necessary for the participants of the so-called special military operation;
- At the base of the "I am Proud" patriotic club, as a part of the "Russia" forum and exhibition at VDNKh (Exhibition of Achievements of National Economy), ShSPU involved participants in writing letters of gratitude to servicemen who participate in the war against Ukraine. The club also produces a series of videos about the fallen participants of the special military operation "Fate and Feat," about whom members of the Young Army from the city of Shadrinsk speak.



FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "VOLGOGRAD STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY" (HEREINAFTER – VSTU)

NUMBER OF STUDENTS:

about 18,000 students.

RECTOR:

Aleksander Valentinovich Navrotsky.

He openly supports the war against Ukraine and the policies that threaten the territorial integrity of Ukraine. In confirmation of this, he signed an appeal in support of the actions of the President of the Russian Federation, Vladimir Putin, regarding the full-scale armed invasion of Ukraine, for which, on June 9, 2022, Ukraine imposed sanctions on Aleksander Navrotsky personally and on VSTU



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

Since 2022, "University sessions" have been held at VSTU, where more than 240 children from the TOT took part. Children engaged in participation in cultural, educational, propaganda, militaristic and other activities, including:

- Excursions to the "Battle of Stalingrad" and "Russia - My History" museums. De-facto, such excursions are aimed at destroying children's Ukrainian identity by forcing them to position themselves as Russians and are also aimed at popularising the Russian Federation, Russian culture, language, symbols, etc.
- Daily lineups with the ceremony of raising the State Flag of the Russian Federation, as well as lectures "Russia and the modern world" and educational module "Understand me" by the public and state educational organisation "Russian Society "Knowledge." In December 2023, the "Knowledge" society was included in the sanctions lists of the European Union and Switzerland for conducting activities aimed at spreading pro-Kremlin disinformation, propaganda of war, and russification of the population in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine.
- Meetings, during which studies in the Russian Federation were popularised, and children from the TOT were campaigned to enroll in Russian higher education institutions.

OFFICIAL AND OPEN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

- Raising funds to purchase medicines for military personnel of the Russian Federation participating in the war against Ukraine.
- Meetings of children with the deputies of the State Duma of the Russian Federation, at which they are encouraged to join construction squads to work in the territory of the TOT.
- Meetings with servicemen of the so-called special military operation, VSTU organises campaigns to write letters to soldiers of the Russian Federation who take part in the war against Ukraine.



FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION "GLAZOV STATE PEDAGOGICAL UNIVERSITY NAMED AFTER V. G. KOROLENKO" (HEREINAFTER – GSPU)

Before 2023, GSPU was a pedagogical institute, but in the summer of 2023, its status was changed to university, and it acquired an engineering profile. Such changes are related to the fact that GSPU will train engineering personnel, in particular, for the state corporation of the Russian Federation "Rosatom" (State Atomic Energy Corporation), which controls the Zaporizhzhia NPP.

RECTOR: Yanina Aleksandrovna Tchigovskaya-Nazarova

She is a deputy of the State Council of the Udmurt Republic of the Russian Federation from the pro-government party "United Russia" and a head of the Udmurt regional branch of the Russian Society "Knowledge." In December 2023, she received a letter of acknowledgement from the general director of the society "for persistent and efficient work promoting the ideas and supporting educational projects of the Russian Society "Knowledge". Tchigovskaya-Nazarova openly supports the war against Ukraine, and in March 2022, she was one of the rectors and higher education institutions who, in their appeal, supported the actions of Russian President Vladimir Putin.



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

"University sessions" at GSPU have been conducted since 2022, in two years more than 400 children from the TOT of Luhansk and Donetsk regions were relocated. Including orphans from the Luhansk orphanage. The "Knowledge" society, which is under sanctions of the EU and Switzerland, is also involved in "University Sessions." Here are several examples of activities that took place during the "University sessions" at GSPU:

- A screening of the Russian military-biographical film about the inventor of the AK47 "Kalashnikov" assault rifle for children and a visit to the Museum and Exhibition Complex of Small Arms.
- Meetings with members of the "Sirius" student law enforcement unit, during which children were taught self-defence techniques. Also, meetings with representatives of the Battle Brotherhood from the city of Glazov.
- Brain-right game (quiz, trivia) "Lessons of War" on knowledge of the history of Russia.
- A teleconference with other Russian higher education institutions for the quiz game "Discovering Russia together" dedicated to the historical monuments and culture of the peoples of Russia.
- Meeting with the "Movement of the First," during which children were told about "such values as love for the Fatherland (namely Russia), respect for the history (for the Russian version of history).

OFFICIAL AND OPEN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

- Students have repeatedly collected humanitarian aid for servicemen of the Russian Federation participating in the war against Ukraine and weaved camouflage nets for them.
- On March 18, a day when the President of the Russian Federation signed the so-called "Treaty on the accession of Crimea to Russia", festive concerts are held at the GSPU in honour of the "Re-unification of Crimea with Russia", and this day for them is filled with pride "for the country and its state integrity". Such actions indicate that the university has been supporting Russia's war against Ukraine since 2014, calling the occupation of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea a return to its "native harbour".

As a result of "University sessions", the university is publishing a manual "University Sessions GSPU-2023: to help organizers", which was prepared under a government order and funded by the Ministry of Education of the Russian Federation. The **main purpose of the publication is** to build a model for the successful integration of "new regions" into the Russian education system through the prism of University Sessions.



FEDERAL STATE BUDGETARY EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION “DON STATE TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY” (HEREINAFTER – DSTU)

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 46,000 (taking into account its six branches).

RECTOR **Besarion Chokhoyevich Meskhi**

He is a deputy of the Legislative Assembly of the Rostov Region from the pro-government party “United Russia.” He openly supports the war against Ukraine and the policies that threaten the territorial integrity of Ukraine – he signed an appeal in support of the actions of the President of the Russian Federation regarding the full-scale armed invasion of Ukraine. The rector notes that the goal of the “University sessions” is to Russify Ukrainian children and stimulate their relocation to the Russian Federation for studies: ***“Our mentors coped with the task set for them – motivated children to study at our university, conducted many patriotic classes, drew them to the history of Russia.”***



RE-EDUCATION OF UKRAINIAN CHILDREN FROM THE TOT:

The “University sessions” program has been held at the DSTU since 2022. DSTU was engaged in logistics, temporary accommodation, and volunteer support for further sending children to places of recreation, covering more than 6,000 children from the TOT. Here are several examples of how DSTU held “University sessions” for children from the TOT of Ukraine:

- The main direction was historical propaganda aimed at indoctrinating Ukrainian children with Russian narratives.
- Representatives of the “Movement of the First” took care of Ukrainian children at DSTU, they held separate days dedicated to the movement of children and youth.
- Lessons on history, the culture of the peoples of Russia, the Russian language, and patriotic education were conducted for Ukrainian children from the TOT, which are aimed at destroying Ukrainian identity – children were told Russian history embellished with the ideas of “one nation, one state.”
- Excursions were held for children from the TOT, in particular to the “Russia – my history” park, aimed at destroying children’s Ukrainian identity by forcing them to position themselves as Russians, and also aimed at popularising the Russian Federation, Russian culture, language, and symbols.

OFFICIAL AND OPEN SUPPORT OF THE WAR AGAINST UKRAINE:

Don State Technical University actively supports the Russian aggression. The logistics centre “Our Word” (“Nashe Slovo”) was created at the university, which is engaged in the collection and transfer of educational and scientific literature to higher education institutions and schools in the temporarily occupied Luhansk and Donetsk regions. In addition, in 2022, 270 applicants from the temporarily occupied territories became students of DSTU.



MAKSIM ALEKSEYEVICH DREVAL

General Director of the All-Russian public and state educational organisation "Russian Society "Knowledge" (in russ. «Rossiyskoye obshchestvo «Znaniye») (since May 25, 2021)

The Russian Society "Knowledge" is a public, non-profit organisation that conducts educational and propaganda work, the formation of intellectual content and organises and conducts free lectures, and various events in the field of education. One of the main goals of this organisation is cultivating patriotism among the younger generation, strengthening international unity, and fighting against "false science" and "falsification of history."

In fact, the "Knowledge" society, headed by Maksim Dreval, organises mass events, including for children, during which Russia's war against Ukraine is glorified, and pro-Kremlin disinformation and propaganda of war are spread.

The EU and Switzerland have already sanctioned the "Knowledge" society.

THE "KNOWLEDGE" SOCIETY IN THE TEMPORARILY OCCUPIED TERRITORIES OF UKRAINE

The "Knowledge" society extends its activities in the TOT of Ukraine – Donetsk, Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia, Kherson regions and the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, where it engages in the process of Russification of the local population, in particular children. Since 2022, representative offices have been opened in the TOT of Zaporizhzhia, Kherson, Donetsk, and Luhansk regions. Maksim Dreval personally conducted a lecture on the topic "Recovery of historical memory in Novorossiya" (note – it refers to the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine, which are interpreted as originally Russian territories) at the event organised by the "Knowledge" society together with the Russian military and historic society.

THE ROLE OF THE "KNOWLEDGE" SOCIETY IN THE "UNIVERSITY SESSIONS" PROJECT

Its role is to conduct lectures and military-patriotic educational activities based on the goals of the society – the cultivation of patriotism and the fight against the "falsification of history." In fact, during such lectures, children are given information about the glorification of Russia, the period of the Great Patriotic War is romanticised, parallels are drawn with the war in the territory of Ukraine, and children are also told about the "return of territories" (note – it is about the TOT of Ukraine).

THUS,

the "Knowledge" society, headed by Maksim Dreval, supports actions that undermine and threaten the territorial integrity, sovereignty, and independence of Ukraine, doing so with funding from the state budget of the Russian Federation, which is responsible for the annexation of Crimea and the destabilisation of the situation in Ukraine.



KSENIA DENISOVNA RAZUVAYEVA

Head of the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs
"Rosmolodyozh" (since May 17, 2021)

Since 2013, in one way or another, Razuvayeva has been de-facto involved in the implementation of the youth policy of the Russian Federation; her professional activity is connected with the pro-presidential political party of the Russian Federation "United Russia" and directly with the President of the Russian Federation Vladimir Putin. Ksenia is a member of the Supervisory Board of the All-Russian Movement of Children and Youth and the Council of the President of the Russian Federation on implementing state policy in the family and child protection field. In 2021, she was awarded the medal of the Ministry of Defense of the Russian Federation "For Strengthening the Combat Commonwealth". It is Razuvayeva, as the head of "Rosmolodyozh," who "bears personal responsibility for the performance of functions assigned to the Agency" - paragraph 9 of the "REGULATION on the Federal Agency for Youth Affairs", approved by the Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation dated May 29, 2008, No. That is, Ksenia Razuvayeva is personally responsible for the activities held by "Rosmolodyozh" in Russia, in the TOT of Ukraine, with the involvement of Ukrainian children.

The powers of "Rosmolodyozh" include, in particular: "implementation of activities regarding civil and patriotic education of youth, cultivation of tolerance in the youth environment, formation of legal, cultural and moral values among young people, as well as dissemination of effective forms of youth participation in public life"; "coordination of activities of the All-Russian Public and State Movement of Children and Youth". "Rosmolodyozh" is actively developing the network of patriotic clubs and centres, where servicemen of "special military operation" are involved as mentors, who "show by personal example what it means to choose serving the Fatherland (note - Russia) as your life's work."

"ROSMOLODYOZH" IN THE TEMPORARILY OCCUPIED TERRITORIES OF UKRAINE

"Rosmolodyozh" spends substantial budgets on raising true patriots of Russia from children in the TOT of Ukraine: with grant funds of the organisation, a school was implemented for leaders and volunteers of Zaporizhzhia regional branch of the All-Russian Public Movement "Volunteers of Victory", where participants will be taught how to cover and conduct patriotic campaigns and events properly, and also how to work with veterans (of Russia) and pass on their history to the new generation. According to the organisers' plan, participants must independently conduct activities aimed at civil and patriotic education after completing the training. In February 2023, Razuvaeva reported that since 2022, "Rosmolodyozh" has been integrating young people from the so-called new regions into the educational programs of the youth policy of the Russian Federation.

THE ROLE OF "ROSMOLODYOZH" IN THE "UNIVERSITY SESSIONS" PROJECT

The Federal Agency for Youth Affairs, which is headed by Razuvayeva, was identified as being responsible for the implementation of the project, together with the Ministry of Science and Higher Education and the Ministry of Education. Also, "Rosmolodyozh" was identified as the main administrator of budget funds by the decree of the President of the Russian Federation, Vladimir Putin, dated January 23, 2023, No. Pr-90. Razuvayeva herself says that trips to Russia help with the education and formation of the true patriots of the country, noting the good practice of the USSR in this regard, at the "More than a Trip" program by "Rosmolodyozh" (in 2023, it was included in the implementation of the "University sessions" project) revived this tradition. Razuvayeva notes that "the young generation is currently the main object of the information war that the West is waging against Russia, and this puts new demands on the work of patriotic education". However, her department is ready to solve such tasks.
